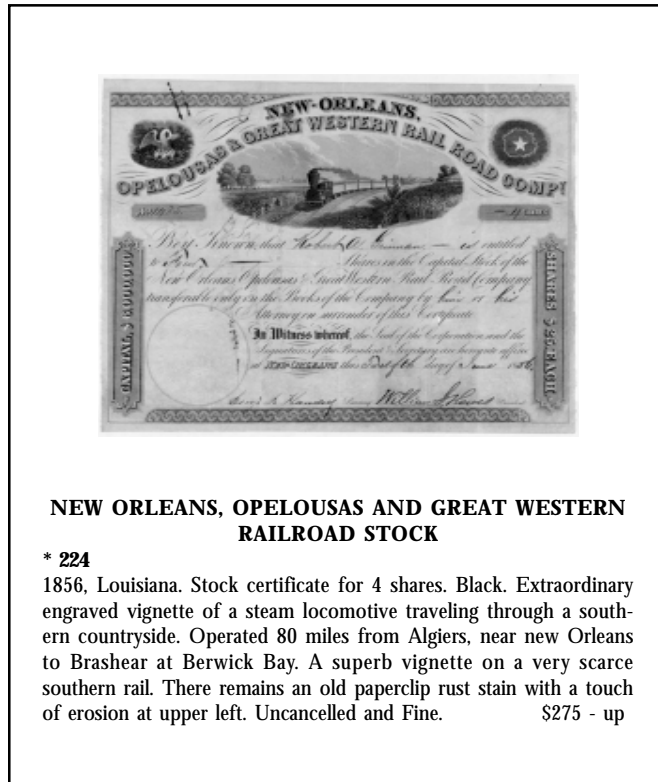
**OTTAWA AND PRESCOTT RAILWAY**

Operated 80 miles from Algiers, near new Orleans to Brashear at Berwick Bay. A superb vignette on a very scarce southern rail. There remains an old paperclip rust stain with a touch of erosion at upper left. Uncancelled and Fine. \$275 - up



**NEVERSINK MOUNTAIN RAILROAD STOCK**

1890, Pennsylvania. Stock certificate for 5 shares. Black. Vignette of a spread-eagle at top center. Litho. Chartered in 1889, the company operated 7 miles of track near Reading, Pennsylvania. It was the third electric railroad in the United States, and the first electric railroad in America operated by water power. The water-power plant of 1000 HP was located at the "Big Dam" on the Schuylkill River, below Reading. Edison electric generators were connected to the water turbines. The railroad was Standard Gauge, 56 lb steel rails were used. Each car had two motors of 25 HP each, these were later increased as they were not sufficient to pull the grades. The Neversink Mountain Railroad ceased operations in 1917 due to financial difficulties. ([berkhistory.org](http://berkhistory.org)). Rare. Uncancelled and Extremely Fine. \$200 - up

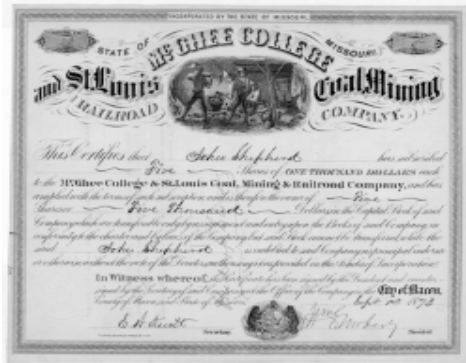

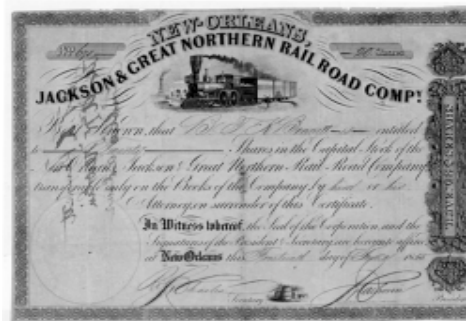

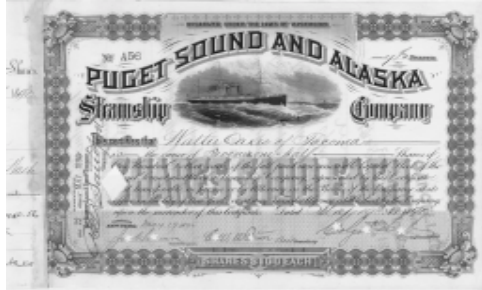

### PUGET SOUND AND ALASKA STEAMSHIP COMPANY

1890, Washington and Alaska. Stock certificate for 7 1/2 shares of the the Puget Sound and Alaska Steamship Company. Brown\Black. Lovely engraved vignette of a steamship in rough seas at top center. Printed by Franklin Bank Note Company.

The company was formed to provide the Northern Pacific railroad with a water route to growing Alaska region. In 1903 this firm merged with Charles E. Peabody's Alaska Steamship Co./Puget Sound Navigation Co., and the resulting company became a leader in Puget sound shipping over the next three decades. As president of the company, Green realized the future importance of the cross-Sound route to Bremerton and led the industry into refitting old mosquito fleet ships to carry autos. By the time he resigned from the company in 1927 to pursue his banking interests, Puget Sound Navigation was ready to dominate the Sound's ferry system under the Black Ball flag until 1951 when the ferries were sold to the state of Washington.

Alaskan steamship related material is quite rare with this being one of only a few companies to surface. Punch cancelled and Very Fine. \$300 - up

What would evolve into a global financial entity began as a general store in the American South. Henry Lehman, an immigrant from Germany, opened his small shop in the city of Montgomery, Alabama in 1844. Six years later, he was joined by brothers Emanuel and Mayer, and they named the business Lehman Brothers. Punch and stamp cancelled. Punch cancellations affect Lehman's signature. \$250 - up

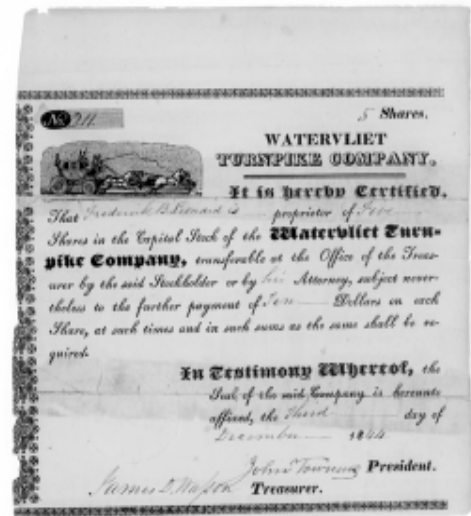

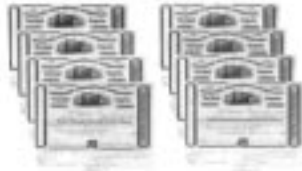

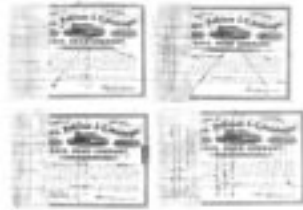
